The Karen Baldwin Research Dissertation Grant provides financial assistance to doctoral students who have an approved dissertation proposal that is primarily focused on Women's Health, including sexuality and gender studies. Preference will be given to students who are majoring in Health Education, Nutrition Education, Counseling Psychology, or Clinical Psychology, but the grant is not limited to these majors.

Recipients will receive the award for the Spring 2026 semester and may be eligible to be selected for the grant for up to three consecutive academic years. However, to be considered, the student must reapply each year in order to be awarded funds in those years. Please note that a submission/resubmission of this application does not guarantee selection of the award.

To be considered for the DDG award, you **must**:

- Be enrolled as a doctoral student for the Spring 2026 semester;
- Be in good academic standing at the time of application and throughout the duration of the academic year in which the grant is awarded; **and**
- Have an approved dissertation topic that is related to Women's Health, with a reasonable defense timeline

***Note: Failure to meet the aforementioned conditions will result in cancellation of your application or the award.**
