

Job Related Graduate Education Certification: Supervisor Instructions

Teachers College provides employees using Tuition Exemption benefits for their own graduate-level education at the College, the opportunity to certify that their education is job-related per IRS tax regulation. That regulation allows the value of job-related graduate courses to be eligible for federal tax exemption.

Supervisors should follow these steps to determine whether a staff member is eligible for the tuition tax exemption:

1.		re the staff member's graduate-level coursework documentation to their current job description's stated & skills, using the following statements as guidance to evaluate if it complies with the IRS job-related

	A.	The education will help the employee maintain and improve knowledge and skills, and is closely related to his or her current position. True False
	В.	The education is required by Teachers College or the law for the employee to keep his or her current position/status. ☐ True ☐ False
	C.	The education is not necessary for the employee to meet the minimum education requirements for his or her current position. ☐ True ☐ False
	D.	The education does not qualify the employee for a transfer or promotion. True False
2.	If either	statement A or B is "True" and statements C and D are "True," sign and date the Certification form.

3. Return Approved forms to the employee for submission to the Human Resources office.

If Denied, provide a reason for the Denial, and return form to the employee. Denied forms should not be submitted to the Human Resources office.

Eligible Advanced Certificate Programs:

In accordance with the Tuition Exemption Policy, Section 4.1.17, there are currently three Advanced Certificate Programs that are eligible for the tuition exemption benefit:

- 1. The Executive Masters Program in Change Management,
- 2. The Summer Principals Academy, and
- 3. The Adult Education Guided Independent Study (AEGIS) Program
