The appointment of the Chairperson of the Advanced Seminar is the responsibility of the Dissertation Advisor who should recommend someone to serve in this capacity. Please review the enclosed Dissertation Committee Matrix for assistance of who can serve as Chairperson.

You must prepare a copy of the outline of your dissertation for every committee member's use at the Advanced Seminar. Confer with each member on what format they want (paper, electronic). Tables showing data most directly relevant to your hypotheses should be attached. Give one copy to each member of your committee <u>at least (1) one week</u> before the seminar.
