# In-Person Research Personal Protective Equipment Fit Test

Please follow the Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Fit Test instructions below:

#### 1. Before Contacting <u>EHS</u>



- Complete or review your research lab or center <u>Job</u> <u>Safety Assessment (JSA).</u>
- Based on your JSA and proposed research activities determine if you or your research team will need to be fitted for PPE.
- Use the "<u>Request for Personal Protective Equipment</u> (<u>PPE)</u>" form to request PPE for your research group through EHS.
- For more information on PPE requests, please see the *green form*.

### 2. Contact EHS

- Research groups should contact <u>EHS</u> (ehs@tc.columbia.edu) with a subject line of "PPE Fit Test Request based on JSA"
  - In your email include your:
    - First and Last name
    - UNI
    - Email address
    - Requested PPE (e.g., N95 mask)

## **3. Day of the Fit Test**

On the day of the fit test:

- Complete the <u>Medical Clearance form</u> that needs to be **submitted to EHS** before the **fitting date by each attendee** 
  - Please use caution when sending documents over the internet.
- All participants must be clean-shaven.
- The whole process should not take more than 10 minutes.

#### 4. Training

- IO minutes.
- EHS will assign all individuals a computer-based training that must be completed before being issued an N95 mask.
