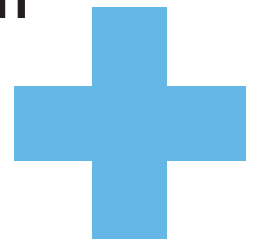


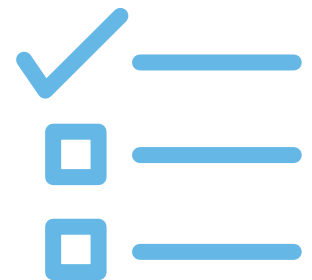
On-Campus, In-Person Research

What to Do if a Research Participant is Unwell

If a participant experiences flu-like symptoms and participated in on-campus, in-person research, the researcher should:



- Immediately cease all in-person activities
- Collect or confirm the participant's contact information
- Advise the participant on the nearest location to get a COVID-19 test
- Ask if you can contact the participant in a few days
- Contact the Office of Public Safety 24/7 at **212-678-3333**
- Explain to the participant that they must leave campus using the same route they followed on entry
- Self-isolate, monitor your health, and follow safety precautions
- Submit an adverse event to the Institutional Review Board (IRB)
- Follow procedures set by the Office of Environmental Health and Safety (EHS)
