## **BURGLARY - REPORTED ON 11/3/25**

TC Public Safety was recently informed of a burglary that occurred on Monday evening, November 3, 2025. At approximately 8:30 p.m., a male presenting individual, tentatively identified by TC Public Safety, wearing a blue baseball cap and a blue jacket, unlawfully entered an apartment located at 517 W. 121 Street and removed property. TC Public Safety is currently working in coordination with the NYPD to investigate this matter.

## Crime Prevention Tips:

- When safe and if possible, do not allow others to piggyback behind you when you are entering a campus building. If you do not feel safe stopping a person from piggybacking behind you, you can always call TC Public Safety (212-678-3333) once you are in a safe location.
- Make sure all doors lock behind you every time you enter or exit your apartment or building.
- Keep a list of all valuable possessions, including the makes, models and serial numbers.
- Stay informed about delivery statuses and estimated arrival times and try to retrieve your package in a timely manner.
