Featured Grants

Robert Wood Johnson Health Policy Research Scholar

Brianna A. Baker, PhD candidate, Counseling & Clinical Psychology, has been selected to participate in one of the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation's leadership programs, Health Policy Research Scholars. She will receive \$30,000 per year for four years to support her research that is committed to helping build a more equitable healthcare system. In addition to participating in the training program, Brianna will conduct her associated research project under the guidance of Dr. Brandon Velez, Associate Professor of Counseling Psychology.

The Community College Research Center (CCRC) was awarded two grants.

The first award, in the amount of \$2.6 million, was made by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation for the project, "Scaling Dual Enrollment Equity Pathways to College and Career Success." Principal Investigator Davis Jenkins, Senior Research Scholar, will co-direct the project with John Fink, Senior Research Associate. CCRC Director Tom Brock will oversee the project's work which seeks to expand efforts by community colleges and their K-12 partners in Florida and Texas to extend equity-focused guided pathways practices to dual-enrollment students from underserved groups.

The second award, in the amount of \$75,000, was made by the <u>Joyce</u> <u>Foundation</u> to Principal Investigator Tom Brock whose project, "Inform College Policy Maker," is focused on providing federal policymakers useful evidence about topics such as community college funding, student loans and debt, transferring from two-year to four-year college, developmental education, and advising reform — all which are central to improving higher education access, support, and completion.
