INSTITUTIONAL REVIEW BOARD (IRB)

The IRB Office is integral to President Bailey's Strategic Plan in the area of research. Aligned with the strategic plan, Human Research Protection (HRP) Consulting Group audited the IRB Office and identified several areas for improvement: (1) increased staffing; (2) updated Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs); and (3) improved protocol submission through Mentor IRB. The IRB staff are working with the Vice Dean for Research and HRP to enact these changes and to further support the research community. While in its preliminary stages, the IRB staff will continue to make exciting announcements about the future of the office. More to come soon!

Child Development and Individual Learning Awards

Collaboration Funds Level 1: Planning Grants

Level 1 Collaboration Planning Funds are designed to promote new collaborations among faculty or to provide faculty who are currently collaborating to explore a new project. The idea is for faculty to have an opportunity to work together and get to know each other's work before launching a larger collaboration. Tenure-track and tenured professors, professors of practice, and research professors are eligible to apply. Projects must involve an interdisciplinary collaboration among a minimum of 2 TC faculty members. A team member from outside TC may be included as long as 2 TC faculty are members of the group. Grant-Writing Coaching Awards
