Emilia: Hello Cassio, I have talked to Desdemona and they agree to take you back in even though you have harmed a famous man from Cyprus

Cassio: Thank You but now let me talk to Desdemona

Othello: Here Iago have the plans to the pilot to give to the Senator

Iago: Right away Othello

Othello: Well men should we continue with our plans?

Gentlemen: We wait for you to begin.

Desdemona: Do not worry Cassio I will do my best to get your job back

Emilia: It seems Iago keeps blaming everything on himself for what happened to Cassio

Desdemona: I know Cassio is very loyal to Othello. I promise you that you have your job back. I will continuously remind Othello.

Cassio: I shall always serve you since you are doing this favor for me

[Enter Othello and Iago]

Emilia: Here comes Iago

Cassio: Then I should leave

Desdemona: Why not stay and speak with me

Cassio: No I cannot since I feel uneasy facing Othello right now

Desdemona: Then leave quietly

Othello: Was that not Cassio leaving?

Iago: I do not think so, why would he leave once he sees you

Othello: No I do think it was Cassio

Desdemona: How are you Othello, I would like to talk about Cassio and that you should give him back his job since he is so very loyal to him

Othello: Then where is Cassio now?

Desdemona: He has just left because he is sad

Othello: We will talk about this later

Desdemona: When, at dinner?

Othello: No I have to meet with the captains.

Desdemona: Then you name the day and time but no more than three days

Othello: When Cassio comes to talk to me I will talk but you have to give me some space to think

Desdemona: Fine. Come on Emilia let's go.

Othello: I love Desdemona very much but then chaos has come in between our love. What do you have to say Iago?

Iago: Did Cassio know of your love with Desdemona?

Othello: Of course Cassio knew about Desdemona. Why would you ask this?

Iago: Nothing just wanted to know.

Othello: Please tell me why you ask

Iago: Well all I am going to say is beware of jealousy

Othello: What do you mean?

Iago: Remember Desdemona had deceived her own father to marry you and that she seems to shake and fear your looks but she is not what she seems

Othello: I still think that Desdemona is true to me

Iago: Well it was only my opinion but I must go [Leave]

Othello: Iago is very honest and have many noble qualities

Why did I marry Desdemona if it is bringing me so much pain.

[Enter Desdemona]

Desdemona: Othello the people of the island has prepared us dinner

Othello: My head hurts

Desdemona: Here use my napkin

Othello: Your napkin is too small, lets just go [Both Exit]

Emilia: At last I got the handkerchief that Iago wanted but this item is very important to Desdemona. I took Iago is here I should give him the handkerchief [Enter Iago]

Iago: Why are you alone?

Emilia: I have the handkerchief that you had wanted me to steal

Iago: Good now give it to me [Exit Emilia]

Now I will give this handkerchief to Cassio so he may return it to Desdemona [Enter Othello]

Othello: Iago I have found out that Cassio really loves Desdemona and is trying to steal her from me

Iago: I am so sorry to hear of this

Othello: Iago you have stayed with me and supported me that I would like to appoint you as my new lieutenant now lets leave.

Iago: I am loyal and I will stay with you forever and yes we should leave.

[enter Desdemona, Emilia, and clown]

Desdemona: Do you know where Cassio is clown?

clown: No I would not dare tell you where Cassio is and that if I tell that Cassio is a liar he would kill me.

Desdemona: Tell me where's Cassio?

clown: I cannot tell you where Cassio is because that would be forcing me to lie. [clown leaves]

Desdemona: Emilia, do you remember where I had lost my handkerchief? It is very important to me.

Emilia: No I do not recall where you lost your handkerchief but look here comes Othello

[Enter Othello]

Othello: What are you looking for Desdemona?

Desdemona: Well I am looking for the handkerchief that you had given to me

Othello: Then we must find it.

Desdemona: No lets talk about Cassio. He is very loyal and has always been there with you

Othello: I will not talk about this [Exit Othello]

Emilia: Can you not say Othello is jealous?  
look my husband and Cassio is coming over

[Enter Iago and Cassio]

Iago: Cassio there is no other way you must talk to Desdemona

Desdemona: What's wrong Cassio?

Cassio: I still would like to serve Othello but he has not said anything to me just yet.

Iago: Is Othello angry Emilia?

Emilia: He just left but left in a strange way

Desdemona: Don't worry cassio I will look for Othello now and I will try to get your job back.

[Exit Desdemona and Emilia]

[Enter Bianca]

Bianca: Go save your friend cassio

Cassio: Why aren't you home?

Bianca: I was going to your home.

Cassio: Here take this handkerchief and copy the pattern for me please.

Bianca: Whose does this belong too anyways

Cassio: I do not know but I did find it in my bedroom and that I like the design.

Bianca: Fine but then you owe me

Cassio: Yes I do but for now lets leave
