H.O.M-Significant

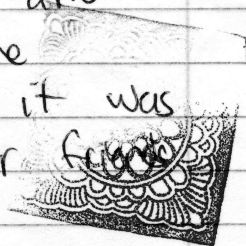

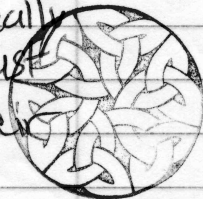

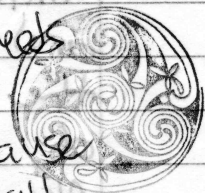
Listening to your friends could be a big impact in your life because it could ~~man~~ help you or destroy yourself.
