Office of Grants and Contracts

The Director of Grants and Contract Accounting at Teachers College, John Hernandez, reported that the federal government has determined the new "Fringe-Benefits" rates and the "Facilities and Administration" indirect costs for academic years 2023-2025. The indirect cost was set at 43%. Current grants that started before FY23 will remain at the previous idc rate of 42.5%. The fringe benefit rate was set at 41% for TC employees and 8.2% for student employees. The lower rate for student employees is meant to provide financial relief and support the continuity of student services.
